Robbins also serves as a teaching pastor at Faithbridge Church in Spring, Texas, and a faculty member in the Doctor of Ministry program at Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary, where he co-leads the doctoral cohorts for Ministry to Emerging Generations. A long-time staff writer for Youth Specialties, Robbins has authored numerous books, including *Ministry of Nurture, This Way to Youth Ministry: An Introduction to the Adventure, Speaking to Teenagers* (with Doug Fields), *Youth Ministry Nuts and Bolts, Enjoy the Silence* (with his wife Maggie Robbins) and *Building a Youth Ministry That Builds Disciples*.



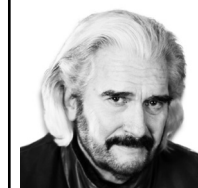
