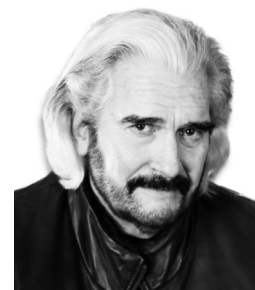

Rev. Dr. Leonard Sweet is the author of over sixty books. His most recent is *Rings of Fire* published by NavPress and Tyndale. He is the Charles Wesley professor of doctoral studies at Evangelical Theological Seminary, E. Stanley Jones Professor emeritus at Drew University, and a visiting Distinguished Professor at George Fox University and Tabor College. Len has authored more than 1500 published sermons. 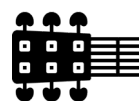
